## Lower Limb Care

Orthotic House provides specialist support for foot and lower limb issues such as plantar fasciitis, diabetic ulcers, arthritis, fractures, and soft tissue trauma. Our orthotists craft custom solutions including insoles that redistribute pressure and improve alignment, footwear that accommodates complex foot shapes, and braces that aid post-operative recovery and joint stability.

These interventions are ideal for a wide range of patients — from elderly individuals needing fall-prevention support, to athletes recovering from ligament injuries.




# Upper Limb Care

We address upper limb conditions including carpal tunnel, tendonitis and fractures through stabilising and functional braces. These support healing, reduce pain, and promote mobility while being tailored for comfort and daily use.



# Compression Therapy

Our compression services help manage lymphoedema, varicose veins, DVT risk, post-surgical swelling and travel-related circulation issues. We supply and custom fit medical-grade arm sleeves, travel sleeves and stockings, and other garments to improve circulation, reduce inflammation, and optimise recovery. All fittings are performed by qualified orthotists to ensure precision and safety.





## Paediatrics

Children with neurological, developmental, or orthopaedic needs are supported with custom-fitted orthoses, including cranial helmets. We prioritise functional outcomes, comfort, and fun designs, working closely with families to support mobility and independence through each growth stage.

Our AFOs are available in child-friendly designs and colours, helping children feel confident and engaged in their treatment.




















## Orthotic Footwear

At Orthotic House, we understand that footwear can make or break the success of an orthotic prescription. Ill-fitting or unsuitable shoes can compromise patient outcomes, delay recovery, and increase the risk of complications. That's why we provide medical and custom footwear solutions designed to integrate seamlessly with orthoses, support rehabilitation, and protect vulnerable feet. Our orthotists work closely with referrers to ensure every patient receives footwear that meets their clinical needs, whether that means accommodating complex foot shapes, AFOs, or significant deformities. We can supply fully custommade footwear, modify off-the-shelf shoes, or provide specialist protective options for high-risk patients such as those with diabetic neuropathy, arthritis, or post-surgical wounds.

- Our team manages approvals with ACC to ensure seamless service.

**DHB Patients (Midland Region):** Patients can be referred directly via BPAC, healthlink, our website or a physical referral form.

**DHB Hawke's Bay Region:** In Hawke's Bay, all public funding referrals must be submitted through contracted DHB referrers.

We maintain an on-site workshop dedicated to design and fabrication, allowing our team to produce high-quality, tailored orthotic solutions. Routine appointments are available on an ongoing basis, with same-day triage for urgent cases. Follow-ups and adjustments are included as part of our service, ensuring your patients receive seamless ongoing support.

We extend care through regular clinics in Rotorua, the Lakes District, Te Kuiti, Huntly, Thames, Waipukurau and beyond. Our orthotists support daily hospital rounds (ICU, paediatrics, elderly care) and participate in multidisciplinary clinics.
